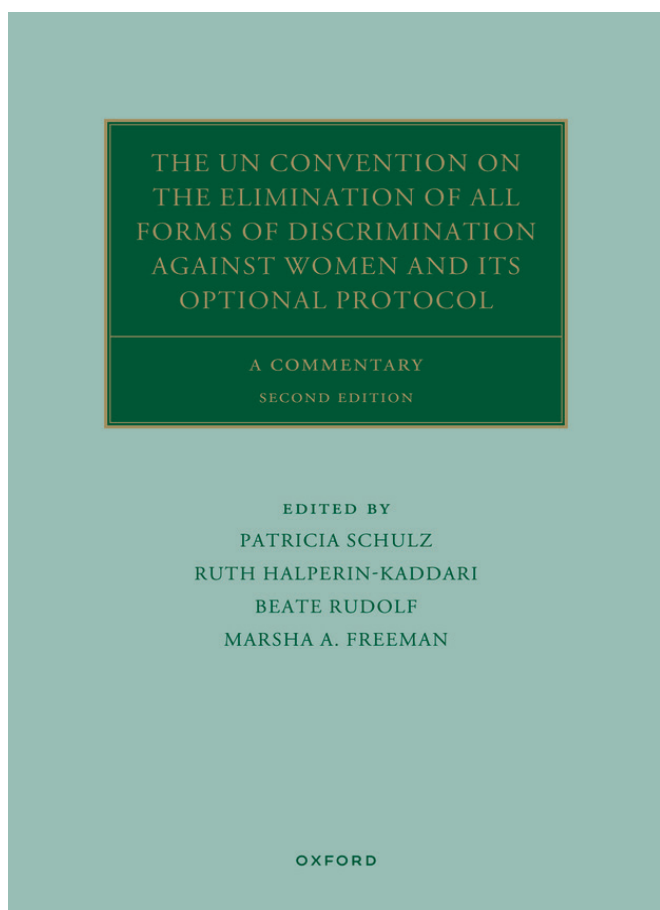


The UN Convention on the Elimination of All Forms of Discrimination Against Women and its Optional Protocol. A Commentary
